## LPN Advanced Placement - Hybrid Bachelor of Science in Nursing

#### The Program

The LPN Advanced Placement program is designed to allow completion of a BSN degree while balancing work, life, and educational goals. Upon graduating from the program *and* successfully passing the NCLEX-RN, you will be qualified to begin working as a Registered Nurse.

- Part-time (10 terms) or full-time (6 terms) plans of study
- Fall or Spring admission
- Earn up to 18 credit hours through advanced placement testing
- All theory coursework online
- Alternate geographical in-person clinical sites possible (based on student enrollment)
- Alternate clinical schedules possible (based on clinical availability)
- Scheduled virtual testing day
- NO entrance exam

#### **Admission Criteria**

- GPA ≥ 2.75 on courses that count toward the BSN degree (including repeated courses)
- An unencumbered PN license (any state)
- No more than one science failure (pertains to BIO 234, BIO 235, BIO 260, CHE 101, AND HEA 240)
- Applicants with more than one science failure may take the ATI TEAS pre-admission exam to demonstrate science proficiency (see Pre-licensure BSN admission requirements)
- Must complete all prerequisite courses and ten or more hours of university core requirements prior to entering the nursing program

#### **BSN DEGREE PREREQUISITES (49 hours)**
