Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the

law of Moses. Beware there-

declare it unto you.

my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Handle me, and fee; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have. And when he had thus fpoken, he shewed them his hands and his feet.
