not only against God, but also benefit of absolution, togetion according to the uttermost fulness. of your powers, for all injuries any other; and being likewife ready to forgive others that have offended you, as ye would have forgiveness of your offences at God's hand : for otherwife the receiving of the holy Communion doth nothing elfe but increase your damnation. Therefore if any of you be a blasphemer of God, an hinderer or flanderer of his Word, an adulterer, or be in malice, : or envy, or in any other grievous crime; repent ye of your holy Table; lest after the taking of that holy Sacrament, the devil enter into you, as he entered into Judas, and fill

of body and foul. that no man should come to the. holy Communion, but with a full trust in God's mercy, and with a quiet conscience; therefore if there be any of you, who by this means cannot quiet his own conscience herein, but requireth further comfort or counsel; let him come. to me, or to some other discreet and learned Minister of God's Word, and open his grief;

Early beloved brethren on - lintend, by God's grace, to celebrate the Lord's Supper: unto which in God's behalf I bid you all that are? here present, and befeech you for the Lord Jefus Christ's fake, that ye will not refuse to come thereto, being fo lovingly called and bidden by God himself. fins, or elfe come not to that Ye know how grievous and unkind a thing it is, when a man hath prepared a rich feast, decked his table with all kind of provision, so that there lack-> you full of all iniquities, and eth nothing but the guests to bring you to destruction both fit down, and yet they who are called, without any cause most And because it is requisite unthankfully refuse to come. Which of you in fuch a cafe would not be moved? Who would not think a great injury and wrong done unto him ?-Wherefore, most dearly belov. ed in Christ, take ye good heed, lest ye withdrawing yourselves from this holy Supper, provoke. God's indignation egainst you. It is an easy matter for a man to fay, I will not communicate, because I am otherwise hindered with worldly bufiness, But fuch excuses are not so

eafily

easily accepted and allowed before God. If any man fay, I am a grievous finner, and therefore am afraid to come: wherefore then do ye not repent and amend? When God calleth you, are ye not ashamed to say, ye will not come? When ye should return to God, will ye excuse yourselves, and say, ye are not ready? Confider earnestly with your felves, how little fuch

when ye wilfully abstain from

feigned excuses will avail before God. They that refused the feast in the Gospel, because they had bought a farm, or would try their yokes of oxen. or because they were married, were not so excused, but counted unworthy of the heavenly feast. I for my part shall be ready, and according to mine office, I bid you in the Name of God; I call you in Christ's behalf; I exhort you, as ye love your own falvation, that ye will be partakers of this holy Communion. And as the Son of God did vouchfafe to yield up his foul by death upon the cross for your falvation; so it is your duty to receive the Communion in remembrance of the facrifice of his death, as he himfelf hath commanded: Which if ye shall neglect to do, confider with your felves how great injury ye do unto God, and how fore punishment hangeth

most heavenly food. These things if ye earnestly consider. ye will by God's grace return to a better mind: for the obtaining whereof we shall not cease to make our humble petitions unto Almighty God. our heavenly Father.

¶ At the time of the celebration of the Communion, the Communicants being conveniently placed for the receiving of the boly Sacrament, the Priest shall Say this Exhortation.

Early beloved in the Lord, ye that mind to come to the holy Communion of the Body and Blood of our Saviour Christ, must consider how Saint Paul exhorteth all persons diligently to try and examine themselves, before they prefume to eat of that Bread, and drink of that Cup. For as the benefit is great, if with a true penitent heart and lively faith we receive that holy Sacrament (for then we spiritually eat the Flesh of Christ, and drink his Blood; then we dwell in Christ, and Christ in us; we are one with Christ, and Christ with us:) fo is the danger great, if we receive the fame unworthily. For then we are guilty of the Bodyand Blood of Christ our Saviour; we eat and drink our own damnation, not confidering the Lord's Body; we kindle over your heads for the fame; God's wrath against us; we provoke him to plague us the Lord's Table, and separate with divers diseases, and sunfrom your brethren, who come dry kinds of death. Judge to feed on the banquet of that therefore yourselves, brethren,
