we give thee humble thanks, that thou hast vouchsafed to call us to the knowledge of thy grace and faith in thee; Increase this knowledge, and confirm this faith in us evermore. Give thy holy Spiritto this Infant, that he being born again, and being made an beir of everlasting salvation, through our Lord Jesus Christ, may continue thy ferwant, and attain thy promise, through the fame our Lord Jefus Christ thy Son, who liveth and reigneth with thee and the Holy Spirit, now and

Then shall the Priest demand the Name of the Child, which being by the Godfathers and Godmothers pronounced, the Minister shall say,

for ever. Amen.

OST thou in the Name of this Child renounce the devil and all his works, the vain pomp and glory of the world, with all covetous desires of the fame, and the carnal desires of the flesh; so that thou wilt not follow, nor be led by them?

Answ. I renounce them all.

Minister.

OST thou believe in God the Father Almighty,
Maker of heaven and earth?

And in Jesus Christhis onlybegotten Son our Lord? And that he was conceived by the Holy Ghost; born of the Virgin Mary; that he suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucisted, dead, and buried; that he went down into hell, and also did rife again the third day; that he afcended into heaven, and fitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; and from thence shall come again at the end of the world to judge the quick and the dead?

And dost thou believe in the Holy Ghost; the holy Catholick Church; the Communion of Saints; the Remission of fins; the Refurrection of the Flesh; and everlasting Life after death?

Answ. All this I stedfastly believe.

Minister.

If thou then obediently keep God's holy will and commandments, and walk in the same all the days of thy life?

Answer. I will.

Then shall the Priest say,

E receive this Child into the congregation of Christ's slock, and

do fign him with riest shall make the fign of the Child's forchead.

Cross, in token that hereafter he shall not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified, and manfully to fight under his banner against sin, the world, and the devil; and to continue Christ's faithful soldier and servant unto his life's end. Amen.

¶ Then shall the Priest say,
Seeing now, dearly beloved
brethren, that this Child
is by Baptism regenerate and
grafted into the body of Christ's
Church, let us give thanks unto
Almighty God for these bene-

fits, and with one accord make our prayers unto him, that he may lead the rest of his life according to this beginning.

¶ Then shall the Priest Jay, E yield thee most hearty thanks, most merciful Father, that it hath pleased thee to regenerate this Infant with thy holy Spirit, to receive bim for thine own Child by adoption, and to incorporate him into thy holy Church. And humbly we befeech thee to grant, that he being dead unto fin, and living unto righteousness, and being buried with Christ in his death, may crucify the old man, and utterly abolish the whole body of fin; and that as be is made partaker of the death of thy Son, be may also be partaker of his refurrection; fo that finally with the refidue of thy holy Church, be may be an inheritor of thine everlasting kingdom, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

¶ Then all ftanding up, the Minister shall make this Exhortation to the Godfathers and Godmothers.

Porafmuch as this Child hath promifed by you his fureties, to renounce the devil and all hisworks, to believe in God, and to ferve him; ye must remember that it is your parts and duties to fee that this Infant be taught, fo foon as he shall be able to learn, what a folemn yow, promife and profession he hath here made by you. And that he may know

call upon him to hear Sermons. and chiefly ye shall provide that be may learn the Creed, the Lord's Prayer, and the Ten Commandments in the vulgar tongue, and all other things which a Christian ought to know and believe to his foul's health; and that this Child may be virtuously brought up to lead a godly and a christian life; remembering always that Baptism doth represent unto us our profession, which is to follow the example of our Saviour Christ, and be made like unto him; that as he died, and rose again for us; so should we who are baptized, die from fin, and rife again unto righteoufness, continually mortifying all our evil and corrupt affections, and daily proceeding in all

these things the better, ye shall

virtue and godliness of living. M But if they which bring the Infant to the Church do make fuch uncertain answers to the Priest's questions, as that it cannot appear that the Child was baptized with Water, In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghoft, (which are effential parts of Baptism;) then let the Priest baptize it in the Form before appointed for Publick Baptism of Infants; faving that at the dipping of the Child in the Font, he shall use this Form of words: TF thou art not already bap-

tized, N. I baptize thee,

In the Name of the Father.

and of the Son, and of the

Holy Ghost. Amen.
