Upon these Feasts; Christmas-day, the Epiphany, Saint Matthias, Easter-day, Ascension-day, Whitsunday, Saint John Baptist, Saint James, Saint Bartholomew, Saint Matthew, Saint Simon, and Saint Jude, Saint Andrew, and upon Trinity-funday, shall be sung or said at Morning Prayer, instead of the Apostles Creed, this Confession of our Christian Faith, commonly called The Creed of Saint Athanasius, by the Minister and Peo-

Quicunque vult. Hosoever will be saved: before all things it is necessary that he hold the Catholick Faith.

Which faith, except every one do keep whole and undefiled; without doubt he shall perish everlastingly.

And the Catholick Faith is this: That we worship one

God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity;

Neither confounding the Persons: nor dividing the Substance.

For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son: and another of the Holy Ghost.

But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost is all one: the Glory The Creed of Saint Athanasius.

equal, the Majesty co-eternal. Such as the Father is, such is the Son: and fuch is the Holy Ghoft. The Father uncreate, the Son uncreate: and the Holy Ghost

uncreate. The Father incomprehenfible, the Son incomprehenfible: and the Holy Ghost incompre-

hensible. eternal.

And yet they are not three eternals: but one eternal. As also there are not three

uncreated: but one uncreated, and one incomprehensible. So likewise the Father is Almighty, the Son Almighty:

and the Holy Ghost Almighty; And yet they are not three Almighties: but one Almighty. So the Father is God, the

Son is God: and the Holy Ghost is God: And yet they are not three Gods: but one God.

So likewife the Father is Lord, the Son Lord: and the Holy Ghost Lord.

And yet not three Lords: but one Lord.

For like as we are compelled by the Christian verity: to acknowledge every Person by himself to be God and Lord; So are we forbidden by the Catholick Religion: to fay, There be three Gods, or three

Lords.

The Father is made of none: neither created, nor begotten.

The Son is of the Father alone: not made, nor created, but begotten. The Holy Ghost is of the

Father, and of the Son: neither made, nor created, nor begotten, but proceeding. So there is one Father, not

three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons: one Holy Ghost, The Father eternal, the Son not three Holy Ghosts. eternal: and the Holy Ghost And in this Trinity none is

afore or after other: none is greater or less than another; But the whole three Persons are co-eternal together: and incomprehenfibles, nor three co-equal.

So that in all things, as is aforefaid: the Unity in Trinity, and the Trinity in Unity is to be worshipped. He therefore that will be
