The Lucile Parker Gallery opened in 1990 and is named for the late professor of art whose work in watercolor brought national acclaim to William Carey University. Each academic year, the gallery hosts exhibits of local, state, and nationally recognized artists. Selections from the Lucile Parker Collection, the William Carey Collection, and the Dr. Larry H. Day Collection are on exhibit during the summer and can be seen by appointment only. Works from each of these three collections can be found around the William Carey campus and play an important role in the aesthetics of the university.

The gallery serves a three-fold purpose: as a teaching tool which allows the students of WCU to have the first-hand experience of viewing art work from both the permanent collections as well as the continually changing temporary exhibits; as a service to the community to further the development both of Mississippi artists and the public who enjoy the fruits of the pursuits of these artists; and as a memorial to the life and work of Miss Parker.
