### Admission Requirements

- Must hold a baccalaureate degree from an accredited school of nursing at a regionally accredited institution
- Submit a completed application to the William Carey University graduate program
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
- Submit a statement of professional goals and current resume
- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 2.5 on the last 30 undergraduate hours
- Submit two nursing recommendations
- Hold an active unencumbered RN license
- Have a clear criminal background check that meets program requirements
