Health Information Management

- Create an individualized plan of study so you are ready to begin the program with annual Fall admission
- Qualify to sit for RHIA certification exam in 18 months
- 100% online courses (remote sessions with course instructors when needed)
- Accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management Education (CAHIIM)
- Program ranked #5 in the country by Healthcare Management Degree Guide
- Requires cumulative GPA $\geq 2.6^*$

*All prerequisite courses must have a grade of C or better, or the course must be retaken.

RN to BSN Dual Enrollment

- 100% online courses
- Can take one online course offered by William Carey University at the respective community college tuition rate for each term actively enrolled in the final year of the academic program OR up to one year following completion of the academic program (maximum of two courses)
- Requires GPA ≥ 2.5 on all courses taken toward meeting the nursing degree requirements
- *All co-requisite courses must have a grade of C or better, or the course must be retaken.
- Must be in the final year of the current academic program and in good standing with university and program
- Students may register for two online WCU courses based upon advisement plan and current course offerings

Health Administration & Education Dual Enrollment

- 100% online courses
- Can take one online course offered by William Carey University at the respective community college tuition rate for each term actively enrolled in the final year of the academic program OR up to one year following completion of the academic program (maximum of two courses)
- Requires GPA $\geq 2.5^*$
- *All co-requisite courses must have a grade of C or better, or the course must be retaken.
- Must be in the final year of the current academic program and in good standing with university and program
- Program eligibility is determined by license, certification, or registry
- Up to 27 hours of elective credit awarded if student has completed a healthcare program and has received a license, certification, or registry
- Students may register for two online WCU courses based upon advisement plan and current course offerings

Dual Enrollment Financial Information

- Dual Enrollment courses offered by William Carey University will be charged at the student's respective community college tuition rate, which will be paid to William Carey University.
- Students must submit a completed tuition discount form to the William Carey University Business Office.
- Payments will be made to WCU for any associated student or course fees.
- Financial aid can not be applied to WCU while dually enrolled at a community college.
