Mississippi Territory in 1798, with three villages of white people, viz: Fort Rosalie, Greenville, and Walnut Hills. Fort Rosalie was the capital. Only one evangelical church in the Territory, the Salem Baptist church, twenty miles northeast of Fort Rosalie.
