Mississippi Territory in 1806, at the time of the organization of the first Baptist Association, with the six Baptist churches in the Territory represented, viz: Salem, Bayou Pierre, New Hope, Bethel, New Providence, and Ebenezer. Washington had become the capital of the Territory.
