## NOTES TO READ BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

- All full-time undergraduate students are required to live on campus with board unless they meet one of the following criteria: age 21, commute from home of parents (within a 50-mile radius), are married, or have children (referenced from The Student Handbook).
- Applicants for the fall term should apply by June 1<sup>st</sup> to ensure choice of roommate.
- A housing application is required in order to live on campus, and a \$150 prepayment is required to confirm your room reservation.
- Non-Private means you may have a roommate. Private means you will not have a roommate. Please make note of the price difference.
- Due to the high volume of requests for on-campus housing, private requests may not always be granted.
- In order to reside Penton Apartments, a student must have 60 credit hours and have lived on the WCU Hattiesburg campus for a minimum of one trimester.
- Room assignments are made based on availability, seniority, and the date your housing prepayment is paid.
- Residence halls are designated as single-gender facilities.
